It puts endemic countries and people affected by NTDs front and centre. It has been used (and continues to be used) by many Heads of State when committing to action for NTDs).

STRATEGY & PLAN – KEY MESSAGES

We wanted to ensure that our different activities stayed connected as a global movement calling for investment in NTDs, while also allowing organisations/groups to add their own messaging that makes it sharper for their disease or country area.


Messaging was split into **two levels**:

1. Core messaging

This was front and centre in all levels of comms. On its own, it was used in broad/high-level contexts e.g. the central call to action, the main pages of web content, media talking points. It awas also the basis to build any targeted messaging.

2. Targeted messaging

For added focus when covering certain diseases or areas. Specific frames and locally relevant arguments, data and proof points were used on top of core messaging.




Today, 30th January, leading organisations and countries announced new commitments to help strengthen efforts to end neglected tropical diseases (NTDs). These commitments, made by endemic countries, donors, and private sector partners, are a response to a global call for urgent investment to control, eliminate and eradicate NTDs by 2030.

NTDs is an umbrella term used to describe a group of communicable diseases that affect over 1.7 billion people. NTDs cause immeasurable suffering. They debilitate, disfigure and can be fatal. They are also a major barrier to economic development.

New commitments announced and posted video messages from Tijana Williams, GSK Director, and Rob Henry, Senior Public Health Advisor for NTDs at USAID, sharing commitments. President of Ghana, Hon. Nana Akufo-Addo also endorsed the Kigali Declaration, and Anesvad Foundation were celebrated for their new commitment.









REACHING THE LAST MILE (RLM)






Are you aware of any responses to World NTD Day? If so, please provide examples.

Our audience increased






Thinking about future World NTD Days, what currently works well and what doesn't work well?

DOESN'T WORK WELL

- In the future, more focus also needs to be given to celebrating at the grassroots level and more media coverage is required.

Sustainable financing is needed to ensure continuity in providing safe, affordable and effective treatments. So far, 47 countries have eliminated at least one NTD, an indication that progress is possible.

The WHO NTD Road map (2021-2030) clearly stipulates that investment in #NTDs can have important benefits for both health and economies. There has been considerable progress in the funding of NTD programs both from governments and donor agencies. A lot still needs to be done to alleviate the suffering in endemic areas. We continue to also promote public responsibility and advocate for policies that will enable a more effective and equitable R&D system that promotes innovation and access.

Ultimately, governments must rise to the occasion, budget for NTD programmes and ensure country ownership and sustainability.

The message is clear: Equity in access. Equity in care. Equity in recognition.

Investing in NTDs is a global health and development success story. So far, 47 countries have eliminated an NTD, showing progress is possible. In 2020, 600 million fewer people required interventions against NTDs than in 2010. Yet, for some time, a lack of resources has been seen as a significant barrier to the control, elimination, and eradication of NTDs. This challenge has only been intensified by COVID-19 which has caused severe delays and disruption to NTD programmes, as well as a massive repurposing and diversion of resources."






